

JOIN THE NOACA BIKE COUNCIL!

NOACA is currently looking for new members for the Bicycle Advisory Council (BAC). The BAC is a group of about 10 people, half public officials and half bicyclists, and its job is to advise NOACA on bike transportation issues. Some of the things we do are:

- 1) Review transportation projects that come to NOACA for funding to see if they accommodate cyclists and make recommendations when they do not.
- 2) Produce bike transportation maps for each of the 5-counties.
- 3) Conduct workshops for local public officials on bike planning and design issues.
- 4) Have project sponsors come to our meetings and give them assistance
- 5) Assist communities in applying to become "Bike Friendly Communities. (Avon Lake, Mentor, and Oberlin have become "BFCs".)
- 6) Numerous other activities, which promote the bike as a transportation vehicle.

We have regularly scheduled quarterly meetings in January, April, July and October and sometimes in between, if needed. The meetings are held at 1:00 pm on a week day at the Cuyahoga County Engineers Office, 2100 Superior Viaduct in Downtown Cleveland.
