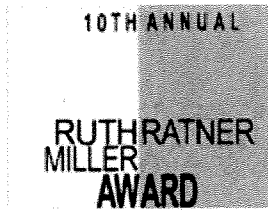
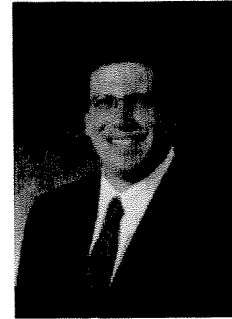


## Ruth Ratner Miller Award Luncheon
