

**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD  
OF THE  
NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA), the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the five Northeast Ohio Counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain and Medina, is presently engaged, through Governing Board action and staff technical work, in the continuing phase of the cooperative, comprehensive planning process designed to meet needs, requirements, goals and objectives of national, state and local governmental levels, all within this nation's federal transportation system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Congress of the United States, through law, and the U.S. Department of Transportation, through regulation, have determined that a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) shall be prepared, which includes federal-aid transportation projects expected to be implemented in each of the program years; and

**WHEREAS**, the NOACA Governing Board's Regional Transportation Investment Policy (Resolution No. 2008-030) requires that all proposed federal-aid transportation projects be processed through project planning review in order to meet Transportation Plan goals and federal requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, project planning review consists of staff technical and policy assessment, committee review, public involvement and Intergovernmental Review and Consultation; and

**WHEREAS**, the following projects have been processed through project planning review:

- a. City of Lakewood: CUY LAKEWOOD STREETSCAPE: PID No. 87617 – This project involves streetscape improvements along Detroit Avenue, between Arthur Avenue and Bunts Road, in Lakewood.
- b. GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (GCRTA) CUY CLEVELAND MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY SUSTAINABLE INTERMODAL TRANSPORTATION FACILITY (SITF) – This project involves planning, design and construction of a SITF located at the Cleveland Museum of Natural History in University Circle in Cleveland.
- c. GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (GCRTA) CUY GCRTA FISCAL YEAR 2010 CAPITAL AND OPERATING PROGRAM – GCRTA is applying for various sources of funds (Section 5301 Formula, Section 5309 Rail Formula, etc.) depending on the type of project (bus, rail, operating, etc.).

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- d. GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (GCRTA) CUY GCRTA HEALTHLINE BUS RAPID TRANSIT SERVICE OPERATION FOR 2010 – This supports operations of the HealthLine, operating along Euclid Avenue, from Public Square in downtown Cleveland to the Stokes Windermere Rapid Transit Station, in East Cleveland. Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) funding in the amount of \$5,760,000 will help pay for operating expenses of the HealthLine.
- e. Village of South Russell: GEA BELL RD (WEST) – This project involves repair and resurfacing along Bell Road, from the South Russell west corporation line to east of SR-306, in South Russell Village.
- f. ODOT 12: CUY D12 PPM FY2011: PID No. 87639 – This project involves preventive maintenance surface treatments along SR-283 from the Eastlake west corporation line (WCL) to the east corporation line (ECL), in the City of Eastlake (Lake County); pavement repair along SR-43 (Aurora Road) in Bainbridge Township (Geauga County) and paving the entrance and exit ramps on I-90 at East 72nd Street and MLK Boulevard, in the City of Cleveland. The project also includes paving the Mayfield and Warrensville maintenance yards.
- g. ODOT 12: CUY SR 17-13.45 SLOPE: PID No. 85003 – This project involves slope repair and erosion protection on SR-17, near the Schaaf Road Bridge, in Brooklyn Heights.
- h. ODOT 12: CUY IR 71-12.45: PID No. 84489 – This project involves replacing the deck of a bridge on West 140th Street, over I-71, in the City of Cleveland.
- i. ODOT 12: CUY IR 90-29.22 L&R: PID No. 87605 – This project involves replacing the superstructure of the twin mainline slab bridges on I-90, over the Lakeland Boulevard connector, in the City of Euclid.
- j. ODOT 12: LAK IR 90-19.21: PID No. 87687 – This project involves replacing the deck of a bridge on Vrooman Road, over I-90, in Leroy Township.
- k. ODOT 12: LAK SR 91-04.56: PID No. 85147 – This project involves replacing the bridge deck on SR-91 over SR-2 in the City of Eastlake.
- l. City of Elyria: LOR CHESTNUT RIDGE RD – This project involves repairing and resurfacing Chestnut Ridge Road, in the City of Elyria, from the west corporation line (WCL) to the east corporation line (ECL).
- m. City of Elyria: LOR GULF RD – This project involves the repair, reconstruction and resurfacing along Gulf Road, from Cleveland Street to Hilliard Road, in Elyria.

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- n. City of Elyria: LOR MIDDLE AVE – This project involves repair, reconstruction and resurfacing along Middle Avenue, from Oberlin Road to Broad Street, in Elyria.
- o. Lorain County Engineer: LOR CR GR FY 2014: PID No. 87529 – This project involves the replacement of existing substandard and/or defective guardrail along Quarry Road, in Amherst Township, New Russia Township, Brighton Township and Wellington Township; Columbia-West River Road, in Columbia Township; Vermont Street, in Penfield Township and LaGrange Township; Hallauer Road, in Pittsfield Township and New Russia Township; and Indian Hollow Road, Penfield Township, LaGrange Township and Carlisle Township.
- p. Lorain County Engineer: LOR SR 57-9.00: PID No. 80993 – This project involves reconstructing SR-57, from the CSX RR to the Grafton Village north corporation line (NCL), 0.09 mile north of Arbor Road in the Village of Grafton.
- q. Medina County Engineer: MED COLUMBIA RD: PID No. 88396 – This project involves resurfacing Columbia Road, from Lafayette Road to SR-18 (Norwalk Road), in Lafayette Township and York Township.
- r. Medina County Engineer: MED FENN RD: PID No. 88703 – This project involves resurfacing Fenn Road, from SR-18 to Marks Road, in York Township.
- s. Medina County Engineer: MED LAKE RD: PID No. 88394 – This project involves rehabilitation and resurfacing Lake Road, from Greenwich Road to Kennard Road in Westfield Township.
- t. ODOT 3: LOR/MED D03 CHIP FY2012: PID No. 82445 – This project involves preventive maintenance along various routes throughout ODOT District 3, in Lorain and Medina Counties.
- u. ODOT 3: LOR/MED D03 CRSEAL FY2012: PID No. 82446 – This project involves preventive maintenance along various routes throughout ODOT District 3, in Lorain and Medina Counties.
- v. ODOT 3: MED D03 TSG FY2012 (B): PID No. 86753 – This project involves performing traffic signal/electrical installation reconstruction at qualifying locations throughout ODOT District 3.
- w. ODOT 3: LOR US 20-22.19: PID No. 82632 – This project involves widening approximately 2.30 miles of Center Ridge Road from three lanes to five lanes, from Stoney Ridge Road to Lear Nagle Road, in North Ridgeville.

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- x. ODOT 3: LOR SR 58-08.34: PID No. 82773 – This project involves resurfacing SR-58, from the Wellington Village north corporation line (NCL) to the Oberlin south corporation line (SCL), in Wellington Township, Pittsfield Township, City of Oberlin and New Russia Township.
- y. ODOT 3: MED D03 BH FY2012 (B): PID No. 80189 – This project involves repairs to twin bridges on I-71, over the Rocky River, in Medina Township.
- z. ODOT 3: MED US 42-19.33: PID No. 86893 – This project involves improvements to the intersection of US-42 and Fenn Road in Medina Township.
- aa. ODOT 3: MED SR 57-16.74: PID No. 83421 – This project involves resurfacing SR-57, from SR-18 to the Lorain County line, in York Township.
- bb. ODOT 3: MED SR 94-18.00: PID No. 87439 – This project involves a culvert replacement on SR-94, 0.25 miles north of SR-303, in Hinckley Township.
- cc. ODOT 3: MED SR 162-20.96: PID No. 87440 – This project involves a culvert replacement on SR-162, 0.28 miles east of Brynwood Road, in Montville Township.

**WHEREAS**, item “w” (LOR US 20-22.19: PID No. 82632), a capacity adding project, was not previously a part of the agency’s existing fiscally constrained long range transportation plan and required emissions analysis for transportation conformity that meets transportation conformity requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the other projects are capacity neutral and do not require an emissions analysis for transportation conformity; and

**WHEREAS**, the project planning reviews may contain recommendations that require project sponsor attention or action; and

**WHEREAS**, it is expected that the project sponsor will, in good faith, endeavor to address comments and recommendations and will provide evidence of such, prior to the project advancing; and

**WHEREAS**, the above project planning reviews were approved and recommended by the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Board of the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency, consisting of forty-four principal officials of general purpose local government throughout and within the Counties of Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain and Medina that:

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**Section 1:** The referenced projects have successfully completed project planning review. The project planning reviews are a part of the projects' permanent record, and will be used in future programming and prioritization decisions. The projects are not subject to additional planning review unless there are significant changes in scope or finances, as determined by the Regional Transportation Investment Subcommittee.

**Section 2:** The project sponsors must endeavor to comply with any recommendations that have occurred as a result of the project planning review and will provide evidence of such in coordination meetings with NOACA staff. NOACA staff will report back to appropriate NOACA committees and the Board regarding the coordination meetings.

**Section 3:** The Executive Director is hereby authorized to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the applicants as well as to appropriate Federal, State and local agencies.
