

ORDINANCE NO. 2272

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH NOACA FOR FUNDING TO UPDATE THE CITY OF CHARDON'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND THOROUGHFARE PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Chardon, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager be and is hereby authorized to file an application with the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) for funds to update the COMPREHENSIVE PLAN and THOROUGHFARE PLAN of the City of Chardon within the city of Chardon and to commit to a 20% match of funds awarded.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare and for the further reason said action is necessary to comply with the application process, this ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
