CUY SRTS FY2009 CLE1: PID 84142 – This project involves Cleveland patrolmen enforcing traffic safety around Cleveland City schools. This project is being funded through the STT SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM LINE ITEM, listed on page 119 of the TIP.

CUY SRTS FY2009 CLE2: PID 84143 – This project involves the purchase of bicycle locks, helmets and renting bicycles for a bicycle rodeo. This project will provide training on bicycle safety. This project is being funded through the STT SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM LINE ITEM, listed on page 119 of the TIP.

CUY US 6-5.33: PID No. 21766 – This project is listed on page 51 of the TIP. The City of Rocky River is the project sponsor. The project as currently portrayed in the TIP involves major rehabilitation along US-6, from the Rocky River WCL to the Rocky River ECL. The project is to be split into two phases:

Phase 1 - CUY US 6-05.33/06.22/07.17: PID No. 84963 – This phase involves resurfacing various sections of pavement (originally part of PID No. 21766) on Lake Road, from the Rocky River WCL to just west of Elmwood Road; just east of Elmwood Road to Moorewood Parkway; and just east of Linda Street to the Bridge over the Rocky River. The estimated construction cost is \$973,500, to be funded with state and local funds. The project currently has an award date of July 2009 (SFY 2010).

Phase 2 - CUY US 6-06.12/06.73: PID No. 21766 - This phase involves reconstruction of Lake Road, at the intersection of Elmwood Road and from Moorewood Parkway to Linda Street. The estimated construction cost is \$3,349,500, to be funded with federal earmark, state and local funds. The project currently has an award date of April 2011 (SFY 2011).

CUY US 42-0.00: PID No. 80983 – This project is listed on page 56 of the TIP. The section should be changed from 00.00 to 00.90.

CUY IR 90-00.00: PID No. 22198 - The cost of the construction phase of this project should be changed from \$1,650,000 to \$2,850,000.

CUY IR 271-10.22: PID No. 23960 – This project is listed on page 68 of the TIP. The section should be changed from 10.22 to 09.37.

Please incorporate this technical amendment into the January STIP amendment as well as ellis as appropriate to enable the sponsors to access funding as needed.
