● **Comments:**

The purpose of this correspondence is to inform you of a technical amendment to the SFY 2008 – 2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), dated May 11, 2007, involving the following projects:

LAK MAGIC MILE: PID No. 80982 - This project was processed and amended to the TIP on December 8, 2006, (Resolution No. 2006-048). The proposed project currently involves constructing a shared use recreational trail, running parallel along the Chagrin River, from SR-84 (at Daniels Park) to US-20 (by Todd Field), in Willoughby. The City of Willoughby (project sponsor) wants to extend the project termini further north, along the Chagrin River, to Chagrin River Park in Willoughby. The sponsor proposes to divide the project into three separate phases as follows:

- Phase 1 - SR-84 to US-20
- Phase 2 - US-20 to Gilson Park
- Phase 3 - Gilson Park to Chagrin River Park

The City of Willoughby is the sponsor of a SAFETEA-LU Earmark (No. 2873). It is the sponsor's intent to use a portion of the earmark funding for preliminary engineering (PE) for the proposed revised project termini (i.e. SR-84 to Chagrin River Park). The estimated cost of the PE phase is \$337,359. Eighty percent (\$269,887) of the cost will be funded with SAFETEA-LU Earmark funds. The City of Willoughby will fund the twenty percent (\$67,472) non federal share.

LAK US020-22.75: PID No. 81526 - This project was processed and amended to the TIP on September 11, 2009, (Resolution No. 2009-026). The project involves resurfacing 4.38 miles of US-20, from Center Road to Green Road, in Perry and Madison Townships. The construction cost estimate should be increased from \$2,730,000 to \$3,487,500. \$2,500,000 of the construction cost will be funded from District 12's Preservation (highways & bridges) Program. \$987,500 of the construction cost will be funded by ODOT. This project has an award date of March 3, 2011.

Attached is the technical amendment sheet portraying the projects in the appropriate years.

Please incorporate this technical amendment into the July STIP amendment as well as ellis management system as appropriate to enable the sponsor to access funding as needed.
