● **Comments:**

The purpose of this correspondence is to inform you of a technical amendment to the SFY 2006 – 2009 TIP involving the following projects:

- **CUY TRI-C ENTRANCE IMPROVEMENTS: PID No. 80972** – Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) is the sponsor of a SAFETEA-LU House High Priority Project (HHPP) Earmark Nos. 1798 and 3431 (Construction of road improvements from Richmond Road to Cuyahoga Community College). The Cuyahoga County Engineer will be the project sponsor.

The project involves improvements to various roadways, parking lot facilities, access drives and curbs located on the Cuyahoga Community College Eastern Campus, in the City of Warrensville Heights.

The project's total construction cost is estimated at \$975,000. Eighty percent (\$780,000) will be funded with 4HC7 funds. Twenty percent (\$195,000) will be provided by the Cuyahoga County Engineer.

The project will be a local-let project, administered by the Cuyahoga County Engineer. Cuyahoga County Engineer intends to sell this project in state fiscal year (SFY) 2007.

- **LOR BROADWAY AVE: PID No. 80508** – The City of Lorain (project sponsor) is the sponsor of a SAFETEA-LU earmark. The project is HHPP Earmark No. 1838 (Reconstruct Broadway Avenue).

The project involves enhancing crosswalks and intersections, with either brick or stamped concrete, along Broadway Avenue, from Erie Avenue (US-6) to Ninth Street, in the City of Lorain.

The project's total construction cost, including construction engineering, is estimated at \$682,500. Eighty percent (\$546,000) will be funded with 4R47 funds. Twenty percent (\$136,500) will be provided by the City of Lorain.

The project will be a local-let project, administered by the City of Lorain. According to ellis, the project has an award date of June 7, 2007. But the city and ODOT 3 expect the project can sell in the first quarter of SFY 2007 and wants to file it as soon as possible.

Attached is a technical amendment sheet portraying the above projects in their respective years.

If **possible**, please incorporate this technical amendment into the July STIP amendment as well as ellis project management system as appropriate.
