SFY 2009 CMAQ PROGRAM

Dear Mr. Calabrese:

I am pleased to inform you the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has awarded \$1,116,000 to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority to purchase two articulated buses. These funds may be used to provide up to 80% of the total project cost.

The Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) Transit Capital Program was established in the 2008-2009 State Budget, providing \$5M of funds each.

These funds will be transferred to FTA and administered by ODOT. Once the transfer is complete and the Federal grant is executed, ODOT will issue a contract in the amount stated above or 80% of the total project cost, whichever is less. ODOT has prepared the CMAQ eligibility request for all projects selected and received the approval from FHWA. No action is needed by you for CMAQ eligibility.

The following documents must be submitted to ODOT by **June 6, 2008**:

- Approved TIP/STIP documentation for the project
- Milestone dates for the following:
 - IFB/RFP out for bid;
 - Purchase order awarded;
 - Delivery of first vehicle;
 - Delivery of last vehicle;
 - Grant completion date.
- Current Fleet Status Report
- DOL Certification

Please submit these documents to Seth Budge in the Office of Transit. This tight deadline is required to meet FTA's grant submission deadline.
