● **Comments:**

The purpose of this correspondence is to inform you of a technical amendment to the SFY 2006 – 2009 TIP.

The amendment involves the following projects:

- **CUY FULTON RD ZOO MITIGATION: PID No. 81349** - This project is a spin-off project of the Fulton Road Bridge project (CUY FULTON RD: PID No. 5394). The project involves environmental mitigation to address the impact of the Fulton Road Bridge construction on the Cleveland Metroparks Zoo. The project includes ball field lighting, temporary Northern Trek access paths and grounds restoration beneath the bridge following completion of the project.

Since this project is an environmental mitigation directly related to the impacts of the construction of the bridge project, \$232,000 of Local Major Bridge (4HC7) funds were moved to this project from the original \$40,000,000 Local Major Bridge allocation for PID No. 5394.

The project's total construction cost is estimated at \$290,000. Eighty percent (\$232,000) will be funded with 4HC7 funds. Twenty percent (\$58,000) will be provided by Cleveland Metroparks.

The project will be a local-let project, administered by Cleveland Metroparks. Cleveland Metroparks will need to sell this project sometime this fall 2006 to coordinate with the Fulton Road bridge project.

- **MED CR BIKE TRAIL: PID No. 23944** – This is an ODOT TE funded project involving the construction of a multi-purpose trail, along an old CSX railroad, linking Chippewa Road to Ryan Road, in Lafayette Township.

The project's total construction cost, including construction engineering, is estimated at \$498,912. Eighty percent (\$399,130) will be funded with 4B37 funds. Twenty percent (\$99,782) will be provided by Medina County Park District (project sponsor).

The project will be a local-let project, administered by Medina County Park District. According to ellis, the project has an award date of June 7, 2006. But ODOT 3 expects the project will sell in the first quarter of SFY 2007 and wants to file it as soon as possible.

Attached is a technical amendment sheet portraying the above projects in their respective years.

Please incorporate this technical amendment into the July STIP amendment as well as ellis project management system as appropriate.
