PREVIOUS ACTION

Presented three times at Policy Committee meetings last year.

BACKGROUND

- **Evolution and refinement of policy in 2nd-4th quarters**
 - General transportation safety fund >
 - Separate planning and implementation tracks (TLCI) >
- **Fundamentals reimagined after valuable feedback**
 - Regional-scale projects
- **Policy paused until after pilot projects (T-EDI, Aerozone)**

PILOT PROJECTS

- **Planning – Support applications for HSIP funds**
 - Richmond Heights – Intersection of Richmond, Chardon, and White Roads, and/or a southern segment of Richmond.
 - North Royalton – Royalton Road (State Route 82)
- **Implementation – Includes design and engineering**
 - Parma – Details to be determined in a later phase
 - Additional project recommended from the Community Safety Reports

FINANCIAL IMPACTS

\$450,000 is allocated for fiscal years 2026 and 2027.

NEXT STEPS

- **NOACA staff will arrange scoping meetings with the planning study partners to pin down the details for preparing an RFP for a consultant.**
- **NOACA will reach out to communities regarding implementation project pilots.**
- **The Policy Committee will be kept informed on TSCI's progress.**
