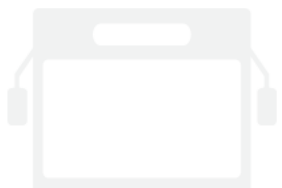

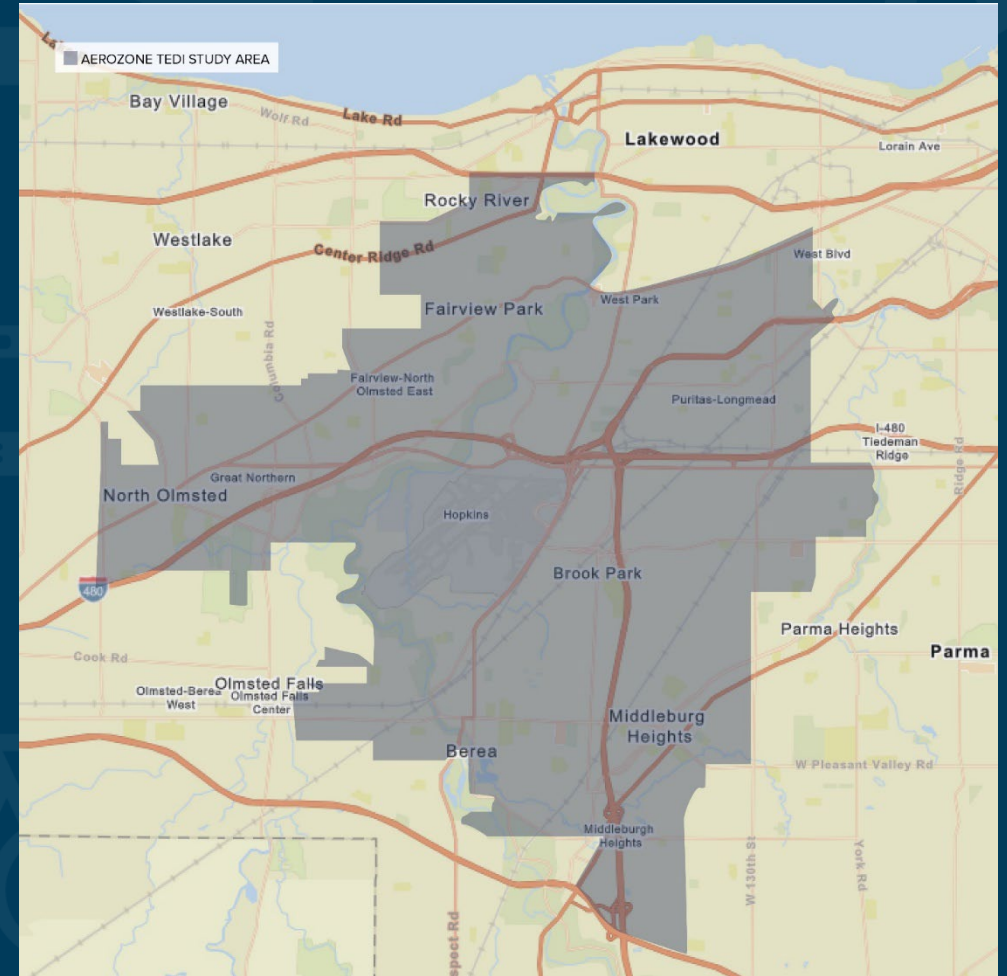
Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities (Section 5310) Program Project Solicitation
