PREVIOUS ACTION

Presented criteria and methodology to evaluate qualifying projects to Advisory Councils, Transportation Subcommittee, and Planning and Programming Committee for input and discussion.

BACKGROUND

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a program of transportation projects to be implemented using Federal funding over the next four-year period.

- July 1, 2027, through June 30, 2031
- Implementation arm of *weNEO2050+* long range plan
- Incorporated into the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)
- Contains ODOT, transit, and NOACA funded projects
- Developed every two years

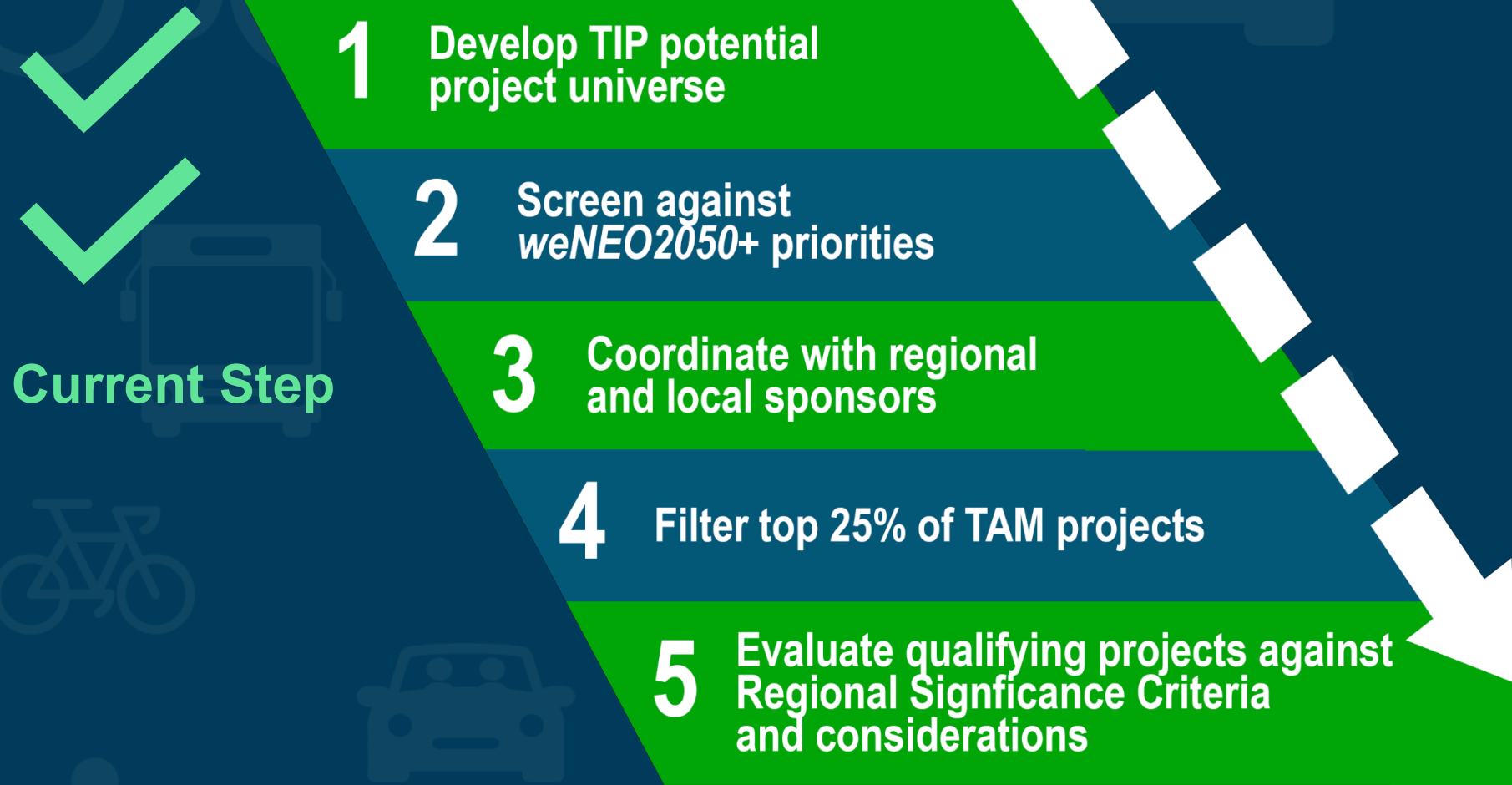
