BACKGROUND

Ohio Revised Code 9.64 – *Political subdivision cybersecurity*

- Effective September 30, 2025
- Establishes deadline of **July 1, 2026, for NOACA**
- Specifies that cybersecurity program-related documents are not subject to disclosure under Ohio Public Records Law
- Requires that the legislative authority of a political subdivision adopt a cybersecurity program

BACKGROUND

State requirements for a cybersecurity program:

- Identify agency's potential cybersecurity risks and impacts of a breach
- Specify mechanisms used by the agency to detect threats
- Specify procedures the agency uses for immediate incident response
- Establish procedures for recovery from and prevention of future cybersecurity events
- Establish cybersecurity training requirements for all employees

BACKGROUND

- **NOACA to engage consultant On Technology Partners to assist in its cybersecurity program development**
- **Scope of work**
 - Assessment of network, hardware, applications, policies, procedures, managed services, and employee training
 - Development of recommendations toward compliance with ORC 9.64 and improving NOACA's information security environment
- **Consulting engagement is \$14,000**
